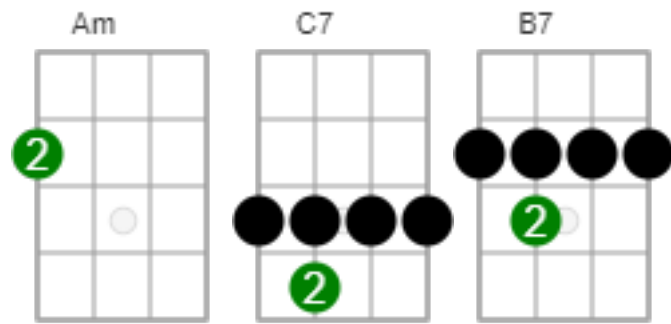
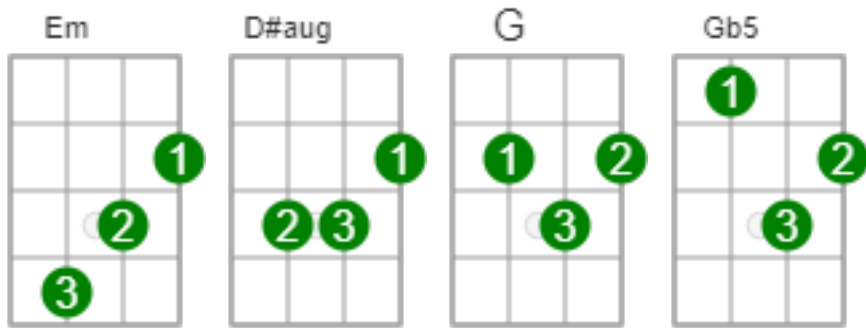

'Cause everything else is obsolete

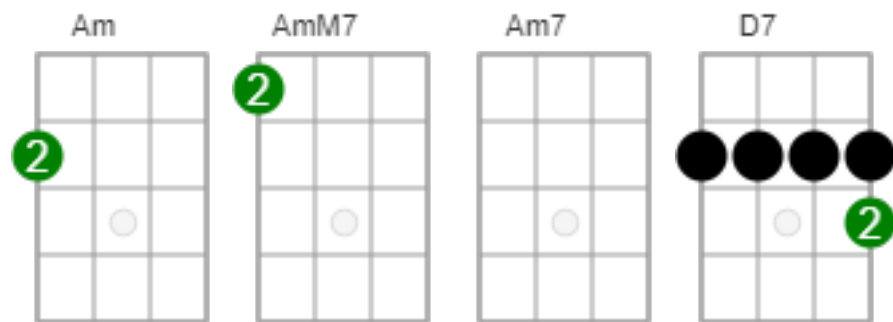

When everybody wants to be a cat

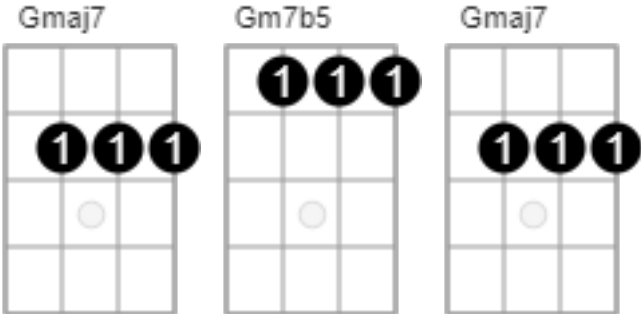
